Charter of Commitments National Cadre Figure skating Season 2024-2025

Preamble

This Charter of Commitments aims to establish a framework of mutual understanding and cooperation between the member of National cadre (hereafter "the skater"), her/his parents and Union Luxembourgeoise de Patinage (hereafter "the Union"). It outlines the responsibilities and expectations of each party involved in the pursuit of excellence in figure skating in accordance with the Rules and Guidelines governing the National cadre.

Commitments of the Skater

1. Dedication and Discipline

The skater commits to maintaining a high level of dedication and discipline in training, adhering to the guidance provided by coaches in accordance with National cadre regulations.

2. Respect for training schedule

The skater pledges to adhere to the training schedule set by the coaches, arriving punctually and fully prepared for each session. The skater must take part in tests and events organized by the Union.

3. Sportsmanship and Fair Play

The skater agrees to uphold the principles of sportsmanship and fair play in all interactions with coaches, fellow skaters, and officials.

4. Openness to Feedback

The skater agrees to be receptive to feedback from the coaches using it as a tool for improvement. The skater is expected to abstain from refusing to accept feedback and making necessary adjustments.

5. Respect for coaches and officials and behavior

The skater agrees to treat coaches, officials, members of the committee, representatives of their club respective and fellow skaters with respect and courtesy at all times.

6. School Commitment

The skater acknowledges the importance of balancing his/her school responsibilities with figure skating training and commits to maintaining satisfactory school performance and undertakes to take all necessary measures to minimize disruptions in his/her studies. The skater is expected to abstain from neglecting academic responsibilities in a way that affects skating commitments.

7. GDPR Compliance for Photo and Data Usage

Major skater gives her/his consent for the use of her/his personal data according to the terms and conditions defined in the seventh stipulation of the commitments of the Union of this charter.

Commitments of the Parents

1. Support and Encouragement

Parents commit to providing unwavering support and encouragement to the skater in their pursuit of figure skating excellence.

2. Financial Support

Parents agree to contribute financially to cover the costs associated with figure skating training, including coaching fees (if necessary), equipment, and competition expenses.

3. Attendance and Punctuality

Parents pledge to ensure the skater's punctual attendance at all training sessions, competitions, and other related events.

4. Open Communication

Parents commit to maintaining open and transparent communication with the skater, coaches, and the Union regarding any concerns, questions, or feedback.

5. Respect for Coaches and Officials

Parents agree to treat coaches, officials, committee members, club representatives and other skaters and parents with respect and courtesy at all times. Parents agree to respect the decisions and recommendations of the coaches and the ULP, as well as the Rules and Guidelines of the national cadre and all federal regulations.

6. GDPR Compliance for Photo and Data Usage

The parents of minor skater give their consent for the use of her/his personal data according to the terms and conditions defined in the seventh stipulation of the Union's commitments of this charter.

Commitments of the Union

1. Quality Coaching and Development

The Union commits to providing qualified coaches and resources necessary for the skater's development, following the Rules and Guidelines established for the national cadre.

2. Safety and Well-being

The Union pledges to prioritize the safety and well-being of the skater, ensuring that training environments are secure and conducive to learning.

3. Transparency and Communication

The Union agrees to maintain open and transparent communication with parents and skaters regarding training schedules, competitions, and other relevant information.

4. Guidance on Competition Participation

The Union will provide guidance on competition selection and entry, considering the skater's level of readiness and developmental goals.

5. Financial support

The Union commits to participating financially in competition expenses according to the established rules for each season.

6. Recognition and reward System

The Union will implement a fair and transparent system for recognizing and rewarding skaters based on their performance, behavior, and commitments, as a means of acknowledging and motivating excellence in figure skating.
