Training Program Highlights

Participants will receive a full training program including:

- 5 masterclasses (50' each), covering selected topics such as Steps and Turns, Spins, Jumping Technique, and Choreography
- 10 semi-private lessons (25' each)
- 10 free ice sessions (25' each)
- 5 off ice Ballet classes
- 5 Specific Off ice Exercises classes
- 4 Theory lessons regarding various useful topics, for instance ISU Regulations and Judging System, Athlete LifeStyle, Planning, Strategy.

Notes: Skaters are supervised only during trainings and the presence of a responsible adult outside these times is therefore mandatory.

Participant cost

- · Cost:
 - CHF 200.00 per skater (includes tuition, ice, use of the facilities)
 - CHF 100.00 per coach (includes attending to all the lessons on and off ice)
- Accommodation: not included in the camp. Rooms can be booked at the hotel "Pension Souvenir" for a discounted price:
 - Double room with private bathroom: CHF 95/night
 - Double room with sink and shared bathroom CHF 70/night
 - Single room with sink and shared bathroom CHF 55/night
 - Breakfast: CHF 10 per person per night.



The city tax is not included (CHF 1.50 for children under 18, CHF 3.00 for adults). Other options are available in Champéry, including rental apartments and hotels.

• Meals: lunch is included in the camp cost. Breakfast and dinner are the individual responsibility of participants.

Assessment and Selection

The number of participants is limited to a maximum of *twenty-four* (24) skaters. Each Member can enter up to a maximum of four (4) skaters and two (2) coaches.

However, due to restricted places, it is not guaranteed that all entered skaters and coaches will be accepted.

The skaters will be divided in two groups of up to 12 athletes each.



Only coaches with skaters attending will be accepted.

The assessment and selection of candidates will be conducted by a committee of coaches from the three Centres involved. Entries from Federations that are currently developing their programs will be prioritised.
